



Resident Property Allowances

- Residents are allowed only 5 complete sets of clothes/outfits (*one outfit is defined as 1 shirt, 1 pair of pants, 1 pair of underwear, 1 pair of socks, 1 WHITE undershirt*) and when working 2 additional uniforms for a total of 7 outfits (this is only if you are working).
- Residents are allowed only 5 pair of shoes to include 3 personal pair of shoes and 2 pair of work shoes.
- Residents may also have 2 pairs of pajamas, 1 sweater OR coat, and one of either shower shoes or slippers (but not both).
- Female residents are allowed one makeup bag only, and all makeup must fit and remain stored in the makeup bag.
- Residents may not order anything online/mail order/phone and have it delivered to themselves at the facility. Those shipments will be returned to sender. Families may send necessities within the first 30 days of the resident's stay, but those items must not exceed property/clothing limits. Any additional clothing, shoes, etc. should be packed up and sent home or labeled and placed in storage closet until release.
- A resident leaving on a weekend pass must bring excess clothing/property with them. A resident with a family member attending visitation must also send excess clothing/property with their family member.
- No electronic/photography devices of any kind allowed, with the exception of basic AM/FM radios. The list of electronic/photography devices that are not allowed includes, but is not limited to, iPods/MP3 players, electronic tablets, e-readers, cameras, CD players, computers, etc. This includes being in possession of any items related to prohibited electronics, such as chargers, boxes, instruction manuals, CDs, or anything else related to those electronic devices mentioned above.
- Harmful chemicals such as bleach are not allowed. Chemicals used for cleaning will be provided by the facility. Aerosol cans are also not allowed, as well as any other chemicals deemed potentially unsafe or harmful to the facility or residents/staff.
- NO SMOKING/TOBACCO PRODUCTS (to include lighters, matches, rolling papers, snuff, cigars, loose tobacco, empty cigarette packs/boxes, cigarette butts, electronic cigarettes, "fake" cigarettes, etc.). The items listed above, as well as any items used for or associated with smoking/tobacco products, are NOT allowed anywhere on or off BVCASA property for BVCASA Residents.
- Residents at the TTC may not use personal or company vehicles while residing at BVCASA.
