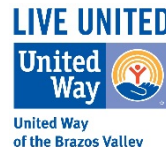

## Adult Outpatient Treatment REACH Program

**REACH Recovery Services** is an evidence-based alcohol and drug outpatient treatment program. REACH is designed to meet the needs of adults, eighteen years or older, who are identified as abusing or dependent on alcohol and/or other drugs. Clients must be medically and mentally stable and willing to commit to a program of abstinence with minimal supervision.



## Adult Outpatient Treatment Services begin with...

**A FREE initial screening** to determine appropriateness for treatment.

**A psycho-social assessment** and individual interviews to identify the client's strengths and weaknesses to develop individualized treatment goals.

## OUTPATIENT PROGRAMS

**Adult Intensive Outpatient Treatment (TRA)** is open to any adult identified as abusing or dependent on alcohol or other drugs. It includes:

- A minimum of 12 hours of service weekly – both individual and group
- Chemical dependency counseling, education and life skills training
- 12-Step support group attendance on non-treatment days encouraged

**Adult Intensive Outpatient Treatment – Specialized Female (TRF)** is open to any adult woman with dependent children and pregnant women identified as abusing or dependent on alcohol or other drugs. It includes:

- A minimum of 12 hours of service weekly – both individual and group
- Chemical dependency counseling, education and life skills training that facilitate stable recovery and preservation of the client's family
- 12-Step support group attendance on non-treatment days encouraged

### Parenting

BVCASA offers a 6 week parenting program, held 2 times a week (a total of 12 sessions), using an Evidenced Based Practice curriculum for parents identified as substance abusers.

### Aftercare

A 3 month aftercare program is offered once a week (12-14 sessions) to individuals who have successfully completed adult outpatient treatment - at no cost for BVCASA Clients.
